SEMI FINALS > FINALS > PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

Just some information for our new members who may be unfamiliar with our processes - To secure a spot in the semi-finals, your team must be ranked in the top four on the ladder. The structure for the semi-finals is as follows: the 1st place team will face off against the 4th place team, while the 2nd place team will go head-to-head with the 3rd place team. The winners of these matches will then compete for the gold and silver medals in the finals. There is no play-off for a bronze medal.

As we approach this critical stage of the season, it's important to note the eligibility criteria for players. To participate in the semi-finals, players must have competed in at least 50% of the games plus one additional game. This rule ensures that those who have been dedicated throughout the season get the opportunity to shine in the playoffs.



Regardless of whether your team makes it to the semi-finals, remember that our club values participation above all else. Every game, practice session, and team meeting is an opportunity to learn, grow, and have fun. Our primary goal is to ensure that every member enjoys their time both on and off the court. We believe that the experiences shared, friendships formed, and memories made are the true victories of the season.

- The last round will roll out in the week beginning 19th August.
- Semi Finals will be played in the week beginning 26th August.
- Finals will be played in the week beginning 2nd September.

NEW SEASON – SUMMER SEASON – PLANNING PROCESS

Whether you're new to Belmont Saints or have been with us for a while, we want to remind everyone about our new season planning process. Next season (Summer), there's a new cutoff date for determining which age group your child will play in. With over 850 members in our Junior and Senior competitions, preparing for the season typically takes us 6-8 weeks. This involves running trials for kids and managing our waiting list of more than 250 children.



The first step is confirming the return of our coaches, which the committee is currently handling. We've also reached out to our Team Managers for help with player return RSVPs. The Summer Season will run from School Term 4, 2024, until the end of Term 1, 2025. If school is on – basketball is on! Here are the age groups for the Summer Season:

- Players born in 2018, 2019, 2020: U8s
- Players born in 2017, 2016: U10s
- Players born in 2015, 2014: U12s
- Players born in 2013, 2012: U14s
- Players born in 2011, 2010: U16s
- Players born in 2009, 2008: U18s boys / Youth Girls
- Players born in 2007, 2006: U20s / Youth Girls

Parents, please inform your team managers as soon as possible if your child will be returning next season. Once we have this data, it will be passed on to our age coordinators, who will facilitate the grading process. Age coordinators and some committee members will also be attending games this term to observe the children's progress. This helps us prepare for grading sessions, which we plan to break into smaller, more manageable groups for our coaches.

Concurrently, we are also reaching out to our Summer Seasonal players to confirm their return. These players participate in basketball during the summer and another sport in the winter. Our priority is to ensure all current members are placed in teams before referring to the waiting list, so your RSVP is important and needs to be timely.

Slight process change notification - As part of our new season planning, once we confirm our coach number and player numbers, you will receive the registration link for the new season <u>in advance</u>. Only children registered in advance will be invited to grading.

A gentle reminder to parents: our age coordinators, coaches, and team managers are volunteers. They have full-time jobs and generously give their time to the club. Please treat our volunteers with respect, as without them, our children would miss out.

Parents - Here's your to-do list for this week:

- 1. RSVP for your child's return next season.
- 2. If your child is switching to another sport, let us know so we can invite them back next Winter Season.
- Encourage your child to give their back field winter season.
- Enjoy the experience! Cheer for your children and celebrate their efforts. Time flies, and soon they'll be all grown up.

The creation of this new brand will enable more teams in the competition without saturating the stadium / competition with more Belmont Saints teams.

There will likely also be an opportunity for people to run squad-based training sessions and more information will be posted on Facebook in the near future as the number of teams / players becomes clearer. FairPlay supports parents, carers or guardians to apply for a voucher valued up to \$200 for eligible Queensland children aged 5-17 to use towards sport and active recreation membership, registration or participation fees.

FairPlay Vouchers are no longer means tested. That means if your child is between age 5-17 years and have a Medicare Card – you can apply for a FairPlay voucher.
